- There are no costs other than \$315 per user for the entire course. This cost includes a two-year subscription to our new and improved Interim Credentials Program. There are five topics within the course (Constructing Your Future, Electrical Job Information 1, Applied Codeology, Electrical Theory 1 – Direct Current, and Construction Drawings). The curriculum has been thoroughly updated with far more content included. All materials required for teachers or students are within the online course.
- Orders will be placed through our bookstore by program administrators responsible for ordering, rostering and enrolling users in the new system. The bookstore will also offer additional materials for classroom use at an additional cost, such as textbooks, code books, calculators, and even additional courses for those that would like to supplement their Interim Credentials curriculum.
- While the previous version of Interim Credentials had a three-week waiting period before invoicing, the new version will allow an initial two weeks of free access. After the free access period expires, the remaining students will have to be enrolled into the two year course. Administrators can now choose their method of payment - online with a credit card or invoiced. Invoices will be immediately generated and available through your account. The entire procurement process is changing, but very user friendly.

Please let your teachers and your designated administrator know to watch their emails closely over the next few weeks. A great deal of information about the exciting updates we've developed for you will be announced through Constant Contact newsletters from the electrical training ALLIANCE.
