- The only cost is \$341.50 per user for the entire course, which includes two years of access to our updated computer-mediated Interim Credentials curriculum. The course covers five topics: Constructing Your Future, Electrical Job Information 1, Applied Codeology Based on 2023 NEC, Electrical Theory 1 – Direct Current, and Construction Drawings. All necessary materials for teachers and students are included.
- Program administrators will place orders online through our bookstore and Training Management System (TMS). Additional classroom materials, such as textbooks, code books, calculators, and extra courses, are available for an additional cost.
- Each user requires both a license and a token. The electrical training ALLIANCE will bill you \$205.89 per license after purchasing from your etA bookstore account. Tokens, which cost \$135.61 per user, must also be purchased for access to the licensed content on the ProTech Skills Institute training management system (PTSI TMS). Tokens will be invoiced separately by PTSI.
- Invoices for tokens will be billed separately through ProTech Skills Institute and should be paid to the remittance address on the invoice or through the provided payment link. Payment options include invoicing, credit card, or ACH for electronic payments.

Licenses and tokens are non-refundable and non-transferable, though administrators can purchase them for future use.
